- Regular health and safety audits and inspections of all worksites and facilities.
- The requirement that all workers and contractors cease work where there is an immediate threat to health and safety.
- Promoting healthy, safe and ecologically-sustainable practices amongst the worksite and local community.
- The provision of regular and relevant training and information to all workers.
- Allocating appropriate resources to manage risks to health, safety and the environment.
